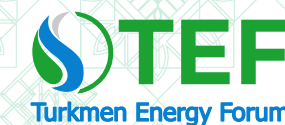

CIET 2026 is designed to become one of Turkmenistan's key international business platforms for construction, architecture, industry, energy, infrastructure, investment and advanced technologies. The event will showcase the country's socio-economic and infrastructure development priorities, promote high-potential projects, attract international expertise, technologies and investment, and expand mutually beneficial cooperation with international companies and organisations.

The CIET 2026 concept is built around the close interconnection between construction, industry and energy as essential pillars of modern economic development. Construction and architecture provide the foundation for cities, housing and infrastructure; industry drives new production capacity and higher-value-added products; and energy provides the reliable base required for sustainable industrial and infrastructure systems.

Across three conference days, an international exhibition and a structured programme of business meetings, CIET will connect strategic dialogue with practical opportunities for investment, technology exchange, localisation, private-sector development and long-term cooperation.

CONSTRUCTION & ARCHITECTURE

Construction and architecture are central to CIET 2026. The programme will explore contemporary architecture and urban planning, residential and infrastructure construction, advanced construction technologies and materials, energy-efficient buildings, sustainable design, Building Information Modelling (BIM), and the localisation of construction materials and equipment manufacturing. The discussion will focus not only on what Turkmenistan builds, but on how the next generation of projects can be designed, financed and delivered with greater efficiency, quality, sustainability and technological sophistication.

Sustainable urban development will be a major focus of CIET 2026. A dedicated United Nations roundtable on Sustainable Development Goal 11 will bring together government institutions, the United Nations system, international organisations, financial institutions and the architectural and construction community. The discussion will examine practical approaches to affordable and high-quality housing, sustainable urban planning, energy-efficient buildings, modern engineering infrastructure, public spaces, sustainable construction materials and technologies, and international experience in advancing inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable cities.

INDUSTRY: LOCALISATION, MODERNISATION & HIGHER VALUE PRODUCTION

The industrial agenda of CIET 2026 will address the creation of new production capacity, technological modernisation of existing enterprises, development of domestic manufacturing, localisation, industrial clusters, competitiveness and export potential. A central objective is to connect international manufacturers, technology providers, engineering companies and investors with Turkmenistan's priorities for modern domestic industries and higher-value-added production.
